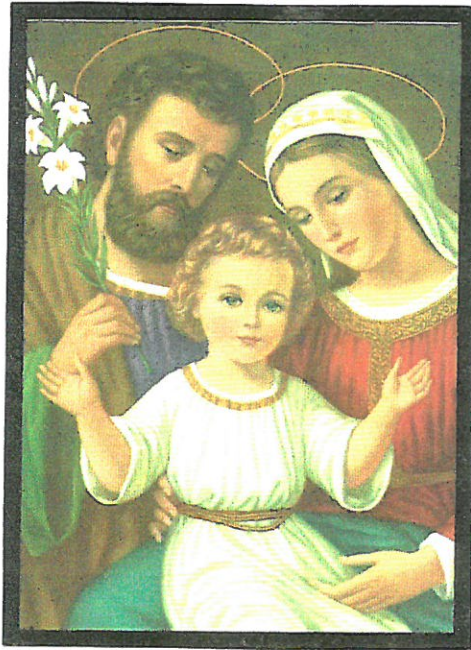


EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION NEWSLETTER
